

Note: An assistant is recommended for the installation of this product.

Step 1: Place vehicle on a flat and level surface. Place gear selector in "Park" and remove keys from the ignition.

Step 2: Locate factory hardware under the bed of the vehicle. (Figure A)

Step 3: Uninstall long factory bolts under the bed. (Figure B) Retain hardware for later use.

Note: To freely remove or move bolts, slightly lift up the bed to align the holes.

Step 4: Uninstall the factory bolts at the bottom outside corners of the bed. (Figure C) Retain the 2 bolts for later use.







Step 5: Align the Rear Bumper (P1) to the bed of the vehicle. (Figure D) Install long factory bolts from Step 3 to bed and rear bumper. Leave hardware loose for adjustment.

Step 6: Install the factory bolts from Step 4 to the rear bumper and bed. (Figure E) Leave bolts loose.

Step 7: Install the supplied hardware through the existing hole of the bed frame and rear bumper. (Figure F) Torque to 24.5 N-m (18 ft-lbs).







Step 8: Torque factory bolts from Step 6 to factory specifications. Tighten the long factory bolts until snug and then loosen until the bed is easy to pivot.

Step 9: This completes installation. Time to ride and enjoy!

ProTip: Periodically check all hardware and re-tighten if needed.
