

Step 1: Place vehicle on a flat and level surface. Place gear selector in "Park" and remove keys from the ignition.

- Note: If vehicle has rear windshield, it is recommended to uninstall windshield to make it easier to install the Spare Tire Carrier. If vehicle has the DragonFire Cargo Rack for the Polaris General, reposition the rack to the rear of the bed per Cargo Rack installation instructions.
- **Step 2:** Lift the bed of the vehicle. (Figure A)
- Step 3: Place P1 into Lock & Ride pockets in the front of the bed. (Figure B)
- Note: P1 can be positioned on leftmost, rightmost, or in the center.
- Step 4: Place P6 and P4 through the holes at the end of the base mount and then install using P7 and P5. (Figure C)



Step 5: Tighten the hardware until the part is fully secured. Ensure the hardware is not too tight that it is flexing the plastic. (Figure D) Then install P8 into the holes of the base mount.

Step 6: Install the Spare Tire Carrier Mount (P2) with 4 sets of supplied hardware. Place P3 through P4, P2, and P1. (Figure E) Then place another P4 onto P3 and loosely tighten with P5.

Step 7: Lower and lock the bed. (Figure F)



Step 8: Use desired spare tire to align the spare tire mount. Then install and tighten lug nuts to specifications of wheel manufacturer. (Figure G)

Step 9: Lift the bed. Then tighten and torgue 3/8" bolts and nuts to 33 lb-ft. (Figure H) When done, lower and secure the bed to vehicle.



Step 10: This completes installation. Time to ride and enjoy!

ProTip: Periodically check all hardware and re-tighten if needed.
