Notice: Do not smoke inside the cab or expose the enclosure to direct flames. Cab is Flammable.

- 1. Be sure to read these instructions thoroughly before opening and installing the 2009-2013 Ranger Soft Rear Window. The installation is best done when the temperature is 70 degrees F. or warmer. The temperature affects the adhesive Velcro, if conditions prevent installing in warmer weather it helps to store the adhesive Velcro at room temperature prior to installation.
- 2. Carefully open the carton and remove the enclosure on a large flat surface that is clean and free of dirt.
- 3. Check over the parts included in the carton with the parts list shown below:

## **REAR WINDOW**

- 1. Begin by placing the 30" adhesive Velcro strip centered across the top of the roll cage. Make sure to place them on top of the bar.
- 2. Next place the 55" strip across the bottom of the frame. It goes on the metal strip that faces the rear of the vehicle.
- 3. Then take the Rear Window and attach it across the bottom first making sure that it is centered properly. Pull it up and attach the top.

4. Next take the 38" adhesive Velcro strips and run it down the back of the roll cage facing towards the rear of the vehicle. Start at the bottom and work your way up the bar. Then attach the sides of the Rear Window here. See photos below.



Cleaning and Storage Recommendations:

- 1. Before removing the Over Armour Cab for storage, make sure it is very clean in order to prevent scratching of the window panels. Clean with a soft rag or sponge using a mild liquid detergent soap and warm water solution. Never rub the windows with a dry cloth or rag! Let the Cab dry thoroughly before attempting to roll for storage.
- 2. It is important that the Cab be rolled up for storage rather than folding. Folding will cause damage to the windows!!! Carefully roll up the Cab similar to the way it was when it was packed at the factory On a large, clean and flat surface, fold the doors over the rear panel first, then, interleave the top and windshield on top of the doors. Begin rolling the Cab into a roll approximately 8 inches in diameter. Put the rolled Cab back into the carton for storage at a normal room temperature. It is best not to expose the Cab to either extreme hot or cold temperatures when storing.
- 3. A special cleaner conditioner is available from Over Armour that will greatly increase the service life of the Cab Enclosure. In addition, if additional hook and loop sets are needed, they can also be ordered.
