


UTV SHOCK GUARDS











FROM THE TOOLBOX

Hex Key Set Marker, nail polish or whiteout Thread Locker

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INSTALLATION

- 1. At the top of the shock tower, mark the position of the helper spring collar with a marker or nail polish. Loosen the collar lock bolt and rotate up the threaded shock body to relieve spring tension.
- 2. At the bottom of the shock assembly, lift the lower spring upward enough to install the shock guard mount (Fig. 1).
- 3. Insert the shock guard mount (Fig. 1) with screw tabs pointing downward.
- 4. Lower the spring back down onto the mount/cradle, then move the helper spring collar at the top of the shock tower back into its original position and secure into place.
- 5. Install the shock guards pointing upward (Fig. 2) so that they cover the springs and lower shock assembly.
- 6. Use a high strength thread locker (Not included) for the supplied hex screw.
- 7. Pre-fit all screws before tightening to ensure alignment and fit (Fig. 2).



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
